### **What's involved?**

The Summer Camp involves taster sessions which are designed specifically to raise awareness and get young folk interested in the outdoors within a fun, rewarding and safe learning environment.

There are 2 weeks that the camp is taking place;

Week 1 – Monday 27<sup>th</sup> July – Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July 09

Week 2 – Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August – Friday 7<sup>th</sup> August 09

**The programme can either be done as a complete week or children may join on as many days as they wish.**

Sessions run daily from 1000 – 1230, break for lunch, 1330 – 1600.

All equipment and specialist clothing provided. Participants should bring (on each day) personal warm clothing (waterproof), swimming togs, old trainers, towel, shower gear and a change of clothing, personal medication (if applicable).

Young people are required to bring their own packed lunch and snacks on each day.

A free daily bus service will also be available from Strangford ferry terminal to CLEARSKY on each day – **09:50am pick up, 16:20pm drop off** (seats are limited and pre-booking is essential).
